

HOW LONG THE MOBILITY COULD BE?

- Traineeships: from 2 to 12 months. One student may participate in mobility periods totaling up to 12 months maximum per each cycle of study, independently from the number and type of mobility activities. The duration of a traineeship by recent graduates counts towards the 12 months maximum of the cycle during which they apply for the traineeship. WHO CAN APPLY?

Eligible students to apply for an Erasmus+ mobility for placement are students, who are registered as full-time students at VUM and cover the following criteria:

- Be selected by an employer that meets the requirements specified in section Profile of the hosting institutions
- Be proficient in the language used at the host institution
- Have a good knowledge of the hosting institution
- Be highly motivated to participate
- Be familiar with the Erasmus+ Student Charter
